QUESTION 1

2 Corinthians 5:18-21 New Living Translation

18 And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. 19 For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. 20 So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" 21 For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

Discuss:

Can you remember who it was who shared the basic 'come back to God!' message with you?

QUESTION 2

2 Corinthians 5:20 New Living Translation

20 So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!"

Discuss:

If it's true that 'you are a message', to what degree have you embraced your identity as an ambassador for Christ? How would you rate the quality of your representation of Him to the world on a scale of 1-10? What needs to change?

QUESTION 3

Discuss:

If it is true that 'you have a message', what step do you feel prompted by the Holy Spirit to take to actually live out your role as an ambassador for Christ to share His message? Can you think of anyone in your life that needs to hear they can 'come back to God!'?





QUESTION 4

Acts 13:1-4 New Living Translation

1 Among the prophets and teachers of the church at Antioch of Syria were Barnabas, Simeon (called "the black man"), Lucius (from Cyrene), Manaen (the childhood companion of King Herod Antipas), and Saul. 2 One day as these men were worshiping the Lord and fasting, the Holy Spirit said, "Appoint Barnabas and Saul for the special work to which I have called them." 3 So after more fasting and prayer, the men laid their hands on them and sent them on their way. 4 So Barnabas and Saul were sent out by the Holy Spirit. They went down to the seaport of Seleucia and then sailed for the island of Cyprus.

Discuss:

How does the action and activity of the early church in Antioch affect you? How do you see something similar happening in our church or in your life?
