## Part 1

Read John 4:13-14

### Discuss:

- A. What do you think it means to 'be thirsty' beyond the physical sense?
- B. How has that kind of thirst showed up in your life, and how have you experienced Jesus satisfying it?

## Part 2

Read Hebrews 1:1-3

### Discuss:

- A. Share about how your understanding of who Jesus is has changed over the course of your lifetime.
- B. How does this Biblical revelation of who Jesus is and what He did affect you or motivate you?

## Part 3

Read Hebrews 2:14-15

### Discuss:

- A. In a way, this passage summarizes the work of Christ in Easter. Is there particular way you have felt the effect of the Devil's power being broken on your behalf?
- B. How is your outlook and your life different because of this?

## Part 4

Read Isaiah 59:1-2 and John 1:29

### Discuss:

- A. How have you personally experienced the reality of sin's separating, disintegrating force?
- B. How have you, and how do you personally experience and engage with the John 1:29 work of Jesus, the Lamb of God?

### Part 5

Read Romans 4:23 and Hebrews 5:8-9

**Discuss:**

- A. What does it mean to you that Jesus is the source of eternal salvation?
- B. When this passage speaks about 'obeying him,' is there a particular area of your life in which you feel the Holy Spirit prompting you to obey Him more?
