Can you remember a moment when you had a sudden change in perspective?

Talk About it!

QUESTION 1

Romans 3:23-24 NIV

23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.

Discuss:

Where in your life have you experienced the redemption of Christ? Where did you once have brokenness or emptiness but now experience His grace and fulfillment?

QUESTION 2

Matthew 28:16-19 New Living Translation

16 Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee, going to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him—but some of them doubted! 18 Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. 19 Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Discuss:

Have there been times in your faith journey when you've had to choose to believe even though it was hard? What can we learn about doubt from this passage? How might God want to meet you in the middle of your doubts?



QUESTION 3

Matthew 28:18 New Living Translation

18 Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth."

Discuss:

In what area of your life do you need to call on or submit to the authority of Jesus (to see breakthrough, redemption, etc.)? What does that look like?

QUESTION 4

Matthew 28:18-20 New Living Translation

18 Jesus came and told his disciples, "I have been given all authority in heaven and on earth. 19 Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. 20 Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age."

Discuss:

What types of "lenses", if any, have held you back from living out this scripture?

What "lens" would be most helpful for you to walk this out more fully? Is there anything that would need to shift in order for you to embrace that perspective?
